

# SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Alabama Horse Council Scholarship is awarded to outstanding youth in Alabama pursuing higher education in a college or university. The Alabama Horse Council Scholarship is awarded to the sons and daughters of AHC members or to an individual AHC member in good standing.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- 1) Applicant, or applicant's parent, must be a current member of the Alabama Horse Council in good standing.
- 2) Applicant must be majoring in a field of study preparing them for a career in the equine industry.
- 3) Applicant must have demonstrated a record of activity in the equine industry prior to college application.
- 4) Scholarship may also be used for Graduate School or Vet School.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Complete the one-page cover form.
- 2) Submit two letters of reference attesting to the applicant's commitment to the equine industry, activity in the industry and character.
- 3) Submit a short (500 word maximum) essay about how horses have shaped your life and the goals you wish to pursue in the horse industry.
- 4) Submit a list of activities and honors received (high school, college, civic, church, clubs, etc.).
- 5) Mail 1 copy of the complete application package (cover form, two letters of reference, essay and activity/honor list) by **December 30, 2018** to:

### SCHOLARSHIP PRESENTATION

- 1) Scholarship winners should plan to attend both the 2018 Alabama Horse Council Annual Meeting and the Alabama Cattlemen's Association convention (usually held in early February) for scholarship presentation.
- 2) Scholarships will be sent directly to your educational institution's scholarship office.

◆Scholarship may be applied to summer or fall term tuition and fees for the calendar year in which the scholarship is awarded.
